## Notice of Race:

### Kitsap Regatta

#### Kitsap Harbor Festival

May 28 & 29, 2011

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS) and US SAILING Prescriptions.
- 1.2. The WSCYC Standard Sailing Instructions for Sinclair Inlet (effective 1/01/2011) (SI) will apply.
- 1.3. The PHRF-Northwest handicapping rules or One Design rules will apply. In the event of disagreement over a rating, the decision of the Race Committee shall be final.
- 1.4. Racing rule A1 will be changed to count all races. No races are excluded in the scoring.
- 1.5. The Racing Rules of Sailing rules 35, A4.2, and A9 will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions or the Notice of Race NOR. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all PHRF ratable boats and boats of the C-Lark and Laser classes. Eligible boats may enter by completing the form provided below.
- 2.2. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

#### 3. CLASSIFICATION

- 3.1. There are three classes. One PHRF class, denoted by the signal flag number 1 (white with red dot); C-Lark class and Laser class, denoted by the signal flag number 2 (blue with white dot). This changes SI Rule 5.2.

#### 4. FEES

- 4.1. For the PHRF class, entry fee is \$30.00, or if a PHRF-NW member, \$25.00, for the entire series. C-lark and Laser class entry fee is \$10.00. Entry fees apply no matter how many races are raced.

#### 5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. Registration: Saturday, May 28, 2011, from 8:30 to 9:30 a.m. or, preregister by sending the completed form and fee to WSCYC, PO Box 1111, Port Orchard, WA 98366 to arrive before May 26, 2011.
- 5.2. Dates of racing: Saturday, May 28 and 29, 2011 for the PHRF Class and May 28 for the C-lark and Laser classes.
- 5.3. There will be one start for PHRF class and one start for C-lark and Laser classes (together) for each race of the regatta.
- 5.4. Number of races: at least three (3) for each class.
- 5.5. Each day, the scheduled time of the first warning signal for the race is 10:00 a.m. The warning signal for the race following shall be after the last boat finishes or the expiration of the time limit. After the last boat of a class finishes, a Postponement (AP) and class flag will be displayed

and dropped one minute before the warning for the next start. This revises the RRS "Race Signals". No race will start after 4:00 p.m. on Saturday or 3:00 p.m. on Sunday.

**6. MEASUREMENTS**

- 6.1. For PHRF class, each boat shall have a valid PHRF-NW rating certificate. For the C-lark and Laser classes, boats shall be essentially "stock" with near equal performance enhancing modifications.

**7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 7.1. The Sailing Instructions are available at [www.wscyc.net](http://www.wscyc.net) in PDF format as "WSCYC Standard Sailing Instructions for Sinclair Inlet (SI).

**8. VENUE**

- 8.1. The race will be held in Sinclair inlet and Port Orchard. The start is adjacent to the Port Orchard Marina breakwater.
- 8.2. The SI shows the location of the racing areas.

**9. THE COURSES**

- 9.1. The courses are given in the SI.

**10. SCORING**

- 10.1. There are no excluded races.
- 10.2. One race is required to be competed to constitute the series.

**11. TIME LIMIT**

- 11.1. For the PHRF class, the time limit for the first boat to finish will be 3 hours for each race. Boats failing to finish within 4 hours will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS Rule 35.
- 11.2. For the C-lark and Laser classes, the time limit for the first boat to finish will be 2 hours for each race. Boats failing to finish within 2-1/2 hours will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS Rule 35.

**12. ALLOWED RADIO COMMUNICATION**

- 12.1. A boat may contact Navy, commercial or private traffic to confirm that they are not going to interfere with that traffic in the foreseeable future. Such communications may only be used to ascertain what action the traffic would like the boat to accomplish. Use channels 13, 14 and 16 as appropriate.

**13. PRIZES**

- 13.1. The PHRF class boat with the lowest score at the end of the regatta shall win the Kitsap Regatta grand prize.
- 13.2. The C-lark and Laser class boat with the lowest score at the end of the regatta shall win the Kitsap Regatta token prize.

**14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 14.1. Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.

**15. INSURANCE**

- 15.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
